GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Assist the state veterinarian, assistant state veterinarian, and Wyoming Livestock Board staff in prevention, control, and eradication of livestock diseases. Work with livestock producers and veterinary practitioners to develop disease control programs for the State of Wyoming. Investigate animal welfare cases. Help develop educational materials, and report to the state veterinarian.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Conducts disease risk assessments and develop herd management plans; Test herds under quarantine for program diseases; Monitor livestock auctions for compliance with Wyoming Livestock Board rules; Foreign animal disease investigation; Investigation of animal welfare complaints; Determine benefit and qualifications for Brucellosis Risk Mitigation Projects; Conduct epidemiologic investigations for reportable diseases; Review permitted feedlots for compliance with Wyoming Livestock Board rules; Coordinate with other agencies on disease control mitigation and investigations; Develop education materials relating to animal disease control; Work closely with Wyoming brand inspectors on disease investigation, epidemiology, and quarantine issues; Prepare and administer federal grants.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS: Skill in interpersonal relations, ability to work as a team member and individually. Strong knowledge in veterinary diagnostics of disease of animals, including livestock and wildlife. Strong knowledge of epidemiology procedures. Ability to work with the public and industry related professionals on a daily basis. Self-starting initiative for daily and special assignments with the ability to coordinate work with others. Proficiency in both oral and written communications. Ability to help coordinate activities in various geographical areas of the state, as well as work with other states' livestock and veterinary industries on issues of mutual concern.
