This Order is issued on this 2nd day of June, 2010 for the purpose of minimizing the introduction of Tuberculosis into Wyoming's cattle industry. It is hereby ordered that:

One negative Tuberculosis test is required on all dairy breeding cattle within 60 days prior to import into Wyoming, including dairy heifers fed for back grounding as breeding or milking stock.


No test is required for steers, spayed heifers, or sexually intact heifers going to a feedlot and remaining in feeding/slaughter channels, animals from an accredited herd, or animals going directly to slaughter.

This order is an amendment to the requirements already found in the Wyoming Livestock Board Chapter 8 Import Rules, Section 20 (g) (iii).

These requirements are implemented to protect the health and viability of the Wyoming cattle industry.

This Order is issued pursuant to Wyoming State Statute § 11-19-103. The State Veterinarian is directed to carry out this Order pursuant to § 11-19-101. This Order remains in effect until further notice.
