Example of a standard brucellosis quarantine protocol

General Conditions:

- An official quarantine notice is sent to the herd owner and/or ranch agent.
- All sexually intact animals are under quarantine. Spayed heifers and steers are NOT under quarantine restrictions.
- A signed quarantine release affected herd plan will be developed and agreed upon between the state veterinarian, federal animal health officials, and the ranch owner/agent.
- Release from quarantine is contingent on completion of appropriate testing and fulfillment of the quarantine release herd plan.

Movement Restrictions:

 Quarantined animals are not allowed to move from the quarantined premise without pre-approval from animal health officials.

Brucellosis Testing:

• Animals eligible for testing: sexually intact Bovidae 6 months of age or older.

Herd test	Required?	
Test 1, 2, and 3: Consecutive negative whole herd tests Must be at least 60 days apart AND The last test must be at least 6 months after the removal of the last reactor.	Yes	
 A post calving test must be one of the three required consecutive tests: Conducted no more than 60 days from the date that the FIRST calf is born in the calving season AND After 90% of the entire herd has calved *Special exceptions can be made by animal health officials as determined by herd epidemiology.* 	Yes	
 Test 4: Whole herd test required only when a provisional quarantine release has been granted to a herd that had its third whole herd negative test conducted less than 6 months after the removal of the last reactor. The provisional release is to allow for movement to grazing allotments. This fourth test shall be conducted within 30 days of return from grazing allotments. 	Yes – If provisional release
